Dear Sherman County School Parents and Guardians,

I am pleased to announce that we will be continuing with meal delivery, starting Wednesday, September 2nd, while the students are engaged in comprehensive distance learning. A few things have changed, however, so please read the following carefully.

The meals will now only be provided for those students who are enrolled at the school, just as if they were physically back in the school building per state and federal regulations. The free/reduced or regular priced breakfast and lunch fees also now apply. However, the income eligibility limits for free and reduced meals have significantly changed to allow more families to qualify. Please reapply as soon as possible as your family may now be eligible. The application can be found on the school website. Go to www.sjshs.weebly.com, the "Information" tab, "Student Registration & Info.", "Meals Application" or go to www.ode.state.or.us/apps/frlapp and apply online. 2020-21 meal prices for those that don't qualify for free or reduced meals are as follows during comprehensive distance learning:

Breakfast: \$2.10 • Lunch: \$2.95

IMPORTANT:

In order to receive these meals throughout distance learning, you will need to sign up with Darcy Carlson, Food Service Manager at dcarlson@sherman.k12.or.us or call Darcy at 541-565-3500. Please sign up at least 24 hours before the day you would like to begin meal service. In the email, please include:

- The first and last names of the students who will be receiving meals
- If they will need breakfast, lunch, or both
- Location where the meals will be picked up Grass Valley, Moro, Wasco, or Rufus
- Please put "Meal Sign Up" in the subject box.

Meals will be made each day for every student that has signed up for meal service. You will only be charged if the meal is picked up. Please contact Darcy Carlson if you would like to make changes to your meal selections, location, or to cancel service.

Our breakfast kits will include items such as cereal bars, muffins, pastries, juice, cheese or yogurt, fruit cups, and sunflower seeds. Lunch kits will include items such as sandwiches, wraps, salads, chips, fresh fruits, and fresh veggies. Milk will also be available.
