March Madness

March 18th to April 7th 2014 is a two week period when college basketball fans go crazy, this national sensation is known as March Madness.

The NCAA Men's and Women's tournament, with games across the country, determines the college basketball National Champions. States with arenas hosting this year's games are Ohio, New York, Florida, Washington, North Carolina, California, Texas, Tennessee, Indiana, Louisiana and Wisconsin. The championship game will be on April 7th at AT&T Stadium in Texas.

Each year 68 of 347 men's teams and 64 of 345 women's teams are invited to "The Big Dance" from Divisions 1, 2 and 3 college basketball. 31 teams are automatically invited for winning their respective conference and the rest are invited by the selection committee. Rating Percentage Index, rating in national polls, conference record, road record, wins versus ranked teams, the way a team finishes the season and adjusted RPI factors into the selection of team to participate in the single elimination tournament.

From there the teams are put into seeds and pods. A team's tournament seed is their placement in one of four regions and pods are a method of grouping seeds in the first or second rounds of the tournament. Each of the winners of regionals continues to the semi-finals where they become

known as the Final Four. The winners of the Final Four games go on to the Championship for the National title.
