Kitchen's New Name

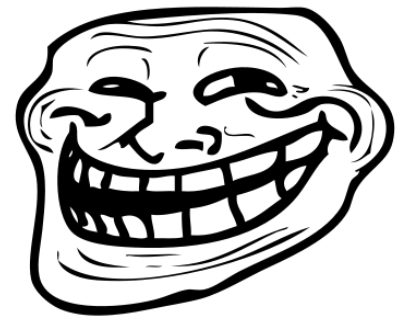
